The meeting was chaired by Mrs., Shristi Singh, IAS, District Commissioner, Majuli. The Additional District Commissioner (Dev.), Majuli on behalf of the chairperson conducted the review of various departments present for the meeting.

The DAO Majuli has also informed that due to high production of Red rice by the farmers of the Majuli district, the department is facing difficulties to achieve the annual target of paddy procurement because the PPC has only procured white rice. • The DAO, Majuli further informed that only 14.5 MT of mustard has been procured against a total target of 300 MT for the financial year 2025-26, attributing the shortfall to high moisture content. • The Additional District Commissioner (Dev.), Majuli directed the concerned department to formulate plans and take necessary steps to achieve the procurement target. All ADOs to take up special drives at micro village level. • DAO, Majuli has proposed taking up special drives for prohibition of paddy supply to other districts. • Additional District Commissioner (Dev.) has directed to submit a report on total numbers of unauthorized mills operating in the district. • Agriculture Department to send an official letter to the SSP requesting for the creation of check posts at border areas of the district to prohibit the outflow of the paddy from the district.
